DEAREST SISTERS!

In the Presentation of the Minutes of the XIIth General Chapter which I addressed to all of you, I wrote: *“We have immediately realized that the Spirit is still to lead us in the "fourth time", the "post-capitular time", the "time" of the incarnation and of the action, having as a mother, as a companion and as a light, the figure of Mary in the Visitation!”*¹.

It is true that time runs fast, it slips out of our hands like water, and we are often overwhelmed by the dizziness of activities, of commitments, of problems to solve and try to manage, of steps forward and backward. That’s why we may enter a dangerous state of anxiety, of bewilderment, of concern, which may cloud our gaze and make us lose our horizon, the only goal towards which everything flows and for which life is worth spending.

This horizon is very clear in the word of the Gospel and in the word of the Founder Don Orione. Providentially, it is also re-proposed, re-created and re-launched every six years, in the celebration of the General Chapter. This is undoubtedly an event of grace for the whole religious Family and for each one of us in particular. It helps us remember the vocation and mission received and welcomed, and renew the commitment assumed with our Religious Profession as LMSC: *“to give ourselves all to God in order to be all for the neighbour”* because *“Caritas Christi urget nos!”*.

The “post-capitular” time has now reached its peak: we are already in the middle of the sexennium. Once again the Holy Spirit calls us to listen to the voice of the XIIth General Chapter and take up again the Conclusions of the Planning Assemblies celebrated at the beginning of this term. Our aim is to give thanks for the fruits already highlighted in our life and mission, to evaluate what still needs to be purified and relaunched, and to set out the second half of the sexennium with enthusiasm, faithfulness and sense of belonging to the Congregation and to the Church.

Therefore, dear Sisters, with this letter I announce to all LMSCs

IN THE LIGHT OF THE GOSPEL

We have been experimenting, for years, that the methodological choice for the meetings, which involve the whole Institute, is not to limit ourselves to the work to be accomplished, but to live a spiritual experience, trying to tune all the aspects that lead, in the end, to a conclusion or making decisions. In this sense, the choice of a biblical context, the harmony between reflections and moments of prayer and celebrations, between the dynamics of work and the fraternal exchange are all fundamental...

Hence, the evangelical framework that was chosen for this year's General Assembly is the one who has been suggested to us by the Holy Father Francis during the Private Audience of the XIIth General Chapter, that is, the meeting between Mary and her cousin Elizabeth (cf. Lk 1: 39-45).

The general theme of the 2020 General Assembly of verification is:

“Blessed are you, who believed!”

This theme will transversely accompany the entire Assembly process, declined, in its different angles, in the previous instances, that is, the Local and Provincial/Regional Assemblies.

IN THE DYNAMICS OF PARTICIPATION

The methodological dynamics of the General Assembly follows the path tested for several years so far, and tries to respond to the criteria of communion and participation, of dialogue and co-responsibility, of unity in diversity.

Therefore, in order for the General Assembly to give positive results for the good and growth of the whole Institute, the active and proactive participation of all LMSCs, through Local and Provincial or Regional Assemblies, is fundamental.

The General Assembly belongs to everyone and every contribution is important. The Assembly constitutes one of the most valid instances, and the right moment for each and all to offer our word, our opinion, to evaluate the experience, to propose solutions. In this way, ALL of us will participate in the General Assembly.

During the Local and Provincial/Regional Assemblies, the methodology will allow us to experience already the event of the General Assembly. They will help us to mature and to grow more and more in the sense of belonging to a unique Religious Family and in the sense of co-responsibility in the development of the charism and the mission of the LMSCs in the Church and in the world.

The methodology that will guide us will be the one we all know, that of the Project of Renewal, with the three steps: 1. Starting from reality, 2. Starting from the Word and the charism, 3. Propose and commit ourselves.

IN SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

“And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it” (John 14:13-14).

The words of Jesus in the Gospel are a light to us and encourage us to trust in Him, to ask with faith, with the certainty of being already listened to. But Jesus addresses the community, he does not say *“ask me”*, but *“ask”*... This is the strength of the prayer of a Community, of a Province, of an Institute united in His name, who actively abandons itself in the hands of the Lord and who humbly asks for listening, discernment and obedience to the Holy Spirit, so that the General Assembly may discover the Will of God today for the Religious Family.

Therefore, in order to feel united in the Assembly celebration, as a great family event, I invite all the communities to pray in communion and with faith, so that the Assembly be a true "*kairos*" that may give new vigour to the charism and mission we have in the Church as LMSCs.

Some prayers have been prepared to add to the intercessions of the Liturgy of the Hours, one for each day of the week. Each community will decide whether to include them in Lauds or Vespers, looking for the moment when the whole community is present.

These prayers are found in **Attachment 1**, at the end of this Letter of convocation and a photocopy will be made for each sister; if it seems appropriate, other people close to us, who wish to join in prayer for our General Assembly, may also be involved.

We will begin these prayers from the moment this Letter arrives to the Community, and will continue until October 31st.

ASSEMBLY ITINERARY

1. Local Assemblies:

The Local Assemblies will be held in each Community **in the months of MARCH and APRIL 2020**. The Communities will receive the dossier with the methodology to be followed and will organize themselves to live this event of the Spirit with serenity, responsibility and sense of belonging.

The participating sisters are all the Sisters of perpetual and temporary vows belonging to the Community and the Novices of the 2nd year.

During the Local Assemblies, the delegates to their Provincial or Regional Assembly will be voted. Only the Sisters of perpetual vows have an active and passive voice.

For the Sacramentine Sisters, there are some specific indications:

- In the provinces or delegations where the communities of Sacramentine Sisters have up to 3 members, all the Sacramentines participate in the Provincial Assembly (Poland, Brazil, Chile and the Philippines).
- Where the communities of Sacramentine Sisters have more than 3 members, the Community will have to vote for one of its delegates at the Provincial or Regional Assembly (Argentina and Kenya). In the case of the Italian Province, which has two Communities of Sacramentine Sisters, they will vote 1 delegate among all the Sacramentine Sisters of the Province to the Provincial Assembly, during their respective Local Assemblies.
- During their Local Assembly, each community of Sacramentine Sisters will vote, from a single list, 2 delegates to the General Assembly, sending the votes to the Superior General in a sealed envelope.

2. Provincial or Regional Assemblies

The Provincial and Regional Assemblies will be celebrated **in the months of JUNE, JULY and AUGUST 2020**. The Provincial and Regional Councils will receive the methodology. The Communities will receive the dossier with the methodology to be followed. The Provincial and Regional Assemblies will take place in no less than five full days, according to the organization of each province, and the participants will try to live this time with serenity, depth, without haste and with genuine commitment to the life and future of the Congregation.

For participation in Provincial or Regional Assemblies, we have applied the criteria and percentages governing participation in Provincial Chapters according to our Constitutions and

General Norms (see Constitutions art. 216 and 217). I also remind you that the Sisters who are in excommunication do not have active nor passive voice.

For missionary Vice-delegations and for the Province of Chile, a special criterion has been applied to their particular reality. Missionary or Sacramentine Sisters who are located in other Provinces or Delegations, (incardinated or not incardinated), will participate in the Assembly of the place where they are.

The General Council has decided not to send any Councillor as an expert to the Assemblies of the Provinces, as it has been applied so far. But there will be a General Councillor in the Assemblies of the Delegation of Madagascar and in the Assemblies of the three Vice-Delegations: Kenya, Ivory Coast and the Philippines.

During the Provincial or Regional Assemblies, the participation of "representatives" of the Juniors and a representative of the various members of the Orionine Family present in the territory is foreseen for a day: Sons of Divine Providence, Orionine Lay Movement, Orionine Secular Institute, Institute Mary of Nazareth.

Juniors can participate in all instances of the Provincial or Regional Assembly, except at the time of the election of the delegates. The invited juniors have no active nor passive voice in the Assembly's decisions.

I present below the calendar with guidelines for the participation of the Sisters in the Provincial/Regional Assembly and for missionary Vice-delegations.

3. General Assembly

a. Participation

For the participation in the General Assembly, which will be held from **5th to 10th OCTOBER**, we have also applied the criteria and percentages that establish participation in the General Chapter (see General Rules art. 226). When voting for the Delegates to the General Assembly, it is important to remember the following: all the Sisters of perpetual vows who are present as elected delegates at the Provincial or Regional Assembly have an active voice. Those who have completed 5 years of perpetual vows at the time of the vote, have passive voice (see General Rules art. 227).

The Sacramentine Sisters who participate in the Provincial Assembly have an active voice in the voting of missionary delegates to the General Assembly (see Constitutions art. 233).

The Provincial or Regional Superior must immediately communicate to the Superior General the names of the Delegates voted for the General Assembly and their substitutes.

b. For the Missionary Vice-Delegations there are some specific orientations:

For the Missionary Vice-delegations of Kenya, Ivory Coast and the Philippines, a certain criterion of participation has been applied, in order to allow a more significant presence of these new, rapidly developing realities, and which represent a great hope for the future for the spread of the charisma in Africa and Asia. Therefore, the General Council, having the power to decide on the matter, invited the Regional Responsibles, accompanied by another Sister of the Vice-Delegation. The three Regional Responsibles, for this specific Assembly, will have an active voice in the decisions.

I present below the participation and the number of Delegates to vote for the General Assembly, for each Province, Delegation and Vice-Delegation:

c. External invited

During some days of the General Assembly there will be some external guests, representatives of the Orionine Charismatic Family:

- The Superior General of the Sons of the Divine Providence (SDP) and the Provincial Superior of Poland
- The President of the Orionine Lay Movement (MLO)
- The President of the Orionine Secular Institute (ISO)
- The President of the Institute Mary of Nazareth.

In addition, Ms. Agnese Salaroli was invited to offer support and help in the secretariat and communications, outside the Assembly.

d. Dynamics and methodology

The General Assembly will take place over six whole days, from 5th to 10th October. The aforementioned method will be followed. The programme will provide dynamics of dialogue, communication and exchange in groups and in the Assembly, a pilgrimage to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Czestochowa and a visit to a charity work of the Polish Province.

You will find practical matters and logistics set out through some important guidelines and indications in **Attachment 2** of this Letter. We remain at your disposal for any doubts or special needs.

For the arrangement of the material and organization of the methodological aid, a "*pre-assembly Commission*" will be convoked, made up of a maximum of four Sisters, among the elected delegates. This Commission will meet in Rome, in the General House, from September 16th on. It will be coordinated by the General Councillor, Sr. M. Françoise.

This "*Commission*", together with me and Ms. Agnese Salaroli, will leave for Poland on September 29th, with the aim of preparing and arranging the place where the Assembly will take place, and providing what may be necessary.

The Sisters members of this "**Commission**" will be appointed by the General Council and convoked immediately after all the names of the Delegates of each Province or Delegation are known.

The Provincial and Regional Superiors and the Responsibles of the Vice-Delegations will offer a report to the Assembly, written and displayed in Power Point, following the indications set out in **Attachment 3** of this letter.

THE ASSEMBLY: EXPRESSION OF LOVE TO THE CONGREGATION

*"The Lord does not give everyone the vocation... always thank the Lord for this singular, particular grace, and try to correspond to it. Consider your humble Congregation as an instrument of God for the propagation of God's love; (...) Consider your vocation and the Congregation: the vocation as a particular grace, and the Congregation as a work inspired by God for your sanctification and for that of other souls, and have great love and zeal for the honour of the Congregation"*².

I have chosen to conclude this Letter of convocation with the words of our Founder.

Don Orione has always insisted on love for the Congregation, on feeling her as a "mother". Even in the last "Good night!" he said to his children: *"The first big one Mother is Mary Most Holy! The second Mother is the Holy Church! The third, small but great mother indeed, is our Congregation!"*³.

The Congregation, we can also say, is the "mother" of our Orionine vocation, the place where each one was called by God to live and develop the gift of the religious vocation. As Don Orione tells us: *"always thank the Lord for this singular, particular grace, and try to correspond to it"*, always remembering that *"the Congregation is an instrument of God for the propagation of His love"*.

Therefore, we are all co-responsible in order to make the Congregation be this *"instrument"* in the Church; and it will be so through our love, our faithfulness, our commitment to holiness, our missionary impetus... so that the love of God may reach all the borders of the world, to the most distant and abandoned, to all!

The Assemblies, such as the Chapters -even more-, are a concrete expression of this love for the Congregation that is in every LMSC. The General Assembly is an expression of our love for the Congregation: it is the place of grace, of the light of the Holy Spirit; it is the place of dialogue and reflection. It is the place of co-responsibility and decisions for the good, for the future, for the development of the charism and mission of the Congregation. In other words, for each of us who, in different times and places, has listened to the vocational call and said her "yes".

So, dear Sisters, the way, the attitude, the willingness to celebrate and participate with love and seriousness in the Local, Provincial and General Assembly, will be the tangible sign of how much we love our vocation and how much we love the Congregation.

Today, at the beginning of the time of the Assembly, Don Orione says to each of us: ***"have great love and zeal for the honour of the Congregation"***.

Let us therefore prepare to celebrate the General Assembly in light of this cry from our Founder.

May Mary Most Holy, *"woman of listening, of decision and of action"*⁴ take us by the hand and give us courage and trust, to "go out" towards the horizons that the Spirit will want to give us in the assembly celebration. May she take us by the hand to go "in haste" -like She did- towards those in

ATTACHMENT 1:
Prayers during the time of the General Assembly

- The prayers will be inserted from the moment the Letter of convocation to the General Assembly reaches the Community, until 31 October 2020.
- One prayer per day will be inserted, at the moment of the intentions during the Lauds or Vespers (the community will choose the moment in which all the sisters may be present).
- At the end of the intentions, all together we will repeat the inserted refrain: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Monday:

Holy Spirit, you who constantly renew the face of the earth, give us in this time of the Assembly, through the intercession of St. Luigi Orione, the light and discernment to read the signs of the times. Give us freedom and openness to *"go and walk at the head of times and peoples, and not at the tail, and don't let us be dragged"*: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Tuesday:

Mary, Virgin of listening and action, you who set out on a journey, as pilgrim and itinerant towards your cousin Elizabeth, help us, in this time of the Assembly, to go out, like you, with courage and joy, in *"itinerant and missionary intimacy"*, towards the flesh of Christ in the most needy and abandoned: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Wednesday:

Divine Providence, you who always guide and support us, help us, in this time of the Assembly, to *"grow in the sense of belonging and evangelical transparency in the administration of goods"*, with co-responsibility, sobriety and Orionine poverty: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Thursday:

Jesus, you who are *"Lord and Master"*, renew in us, in this time of the Assembly, our openness and love for young people, which was in the heart of Don Orione, and make us commit ourselves, with enthusiasm and co-responsibility, to Vocational Youth Pastoral of the Congregation: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Friday:

Jesus, Good Shepherd, in this time of the Assembly, purify our service of authority from any residue of superiority, authoritarianism and self-sufficiency, so that we may embody a model of government based on the pedagogy of walking *"in front, besides and behind the flock"*: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Saturday:

Mary, model of consecrated woman, may we learn from you, in this time of the Assembly, to be *"women totally consecrated to Christ, joyful missionary disciples"*, in order to make fruitful and peaceful the life of the old Sisters, faithful and creative the life of the adult Sisters, and perseverant and joyful the life of the young Sisters in formation: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

Sunday:

We thank you Father, for giving us the Vow of Charity in the footsteps of Don Orione. Help us, in this time of the Assembly, to be coherent with this commitment, to live charity in the community and witness it among the people, with maternal tenderness and mercy: **BECAUSE "CARITAS CHRISTI URGET NOS!"**.

ATTACHMENT 2: Practical and logistical issues for the General Assembly

In order to be able to carry out **the General Assembly** with order and peace, I would like to ask you to keep in mind some practical things, particularly for the Sisters who will be elected at the General Assembly in Poland:

- It is important to arrive at least two days before and leave at least two days later, since Zduńska Wola is located about 200 km from Warsaw, and the transport of the delegates must be organized in time and without haste.
- By **September 5th**, send to the Secretary General, Sr. M. Françoise (e-mail: mariefrancoise@psmc.it) the date of the trips, round trips, highlighting those among you who will make a stopover and stay in Italy before continuing to Poland, so that we can organize your welcoming and transfers to the airport.

- **To enter Italy and Poland:**

The Sisters of: Argentina, Chile, Brazil, Uruguay, Paraguay, Peru **do not need** a Visa.

The Sisters of: Kenya, Ivory Coast, Madagascar, Capo Verde **need a Tourist Visa** (except for those who already have a valid Italian stay). Those who stop in Italy will need two Visas (one for Italy and one for Poland). I recommend that you start your visa application as soon as possible.

Please, all check that your passports are valid for at least 6 months before expiry, otherwise you will not be allowed to leave your country.

- The official language of the General Assembly will be Italian. For simultaneous translation, each one may bring her mobile phone with radio or a small radio with earphones.
- For prayer and celebrations, we ask you to download in your mobile phone **the application of the Liturgy of the hours of the Italian Episcopal Conference (CEI)**, for the prayers that will be held in Italian; other different digital applications can be used to pray in other languages. Each Province or Delegation bring a leaflet of maximum two/three pages with the songs that can be useful for moments of prayer in your own language, and photocopies to be delivered to each participant.
- The climate in Poland for the month of October is usually quite cold, therefore, wear suitable clothing for any temperature change as a precaution.
- If any Sister needs a particular diet, please communicate it to Sr. M. Józefa Kalinowska (e-mail: mariajozefa.psmc@gmail.com), in order to attend this need.
- The whole organization and preparation of the Assembly is the responsibility of the General Council. Those who can offer an economic collaboration, especially for the use of the House of Spirituality, can directly contact the General Treasurer Sr. M. Józefa Kalinowska.

ATTACHMENT 3:
Outlines for the report to the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of the Provincial/Regional Superior and Responsible

During the General Assembly, the methodology of **the first evaluation part** foresees the intervention of each reality. Therefore, each Provincial Superior, the Regional Superior and the Responsible of the Missionary Vice-Delegations, will present a report according to the following guidelines:

- The report must not exceed **20 minutes**.
- It will be read in **Italian**.
- It will be presented in **Power Point** and also in written paper text to be delivered to the General Council. Use **synthetic language**, non-discursive, in order to be able to stay on schedule.

Content of the report:

a. Brief statistics:

- On people (Sisters of Perpetual Vows, Temporary Vows, novices, postulants, aspirants in concrete discernment)
- New openings, closings or withdrawals.

b. Challenges and concrete perspectives of future:

- in the field of the mission of the Institute,
- in the field of ongoing and initial formation,
- in the field of the style of government/animation and management of works.

c. Urgent concrete discernments to be accomplished in the Province/Delegation/Vice-Delegation
