Liturgia - Liturgy

The liturgy is the public prayer of the Church: according to the words of the Second Vatican Council, is the "culmination towards which the activity of the of the Church; at the same time, it is the source from which flows all its strength"

(Sacrosanctum Concilium, 10). At the centre of the Christian liturgy is the Mass – the Eucharistic celebration, where they are truly received the Body and Blood of Christ.

Like a pilgrim, Christ He himself walks beside the disciples and reveals to them the mysteries of the Father, that they too may say as the disciples said about the Emmaus Road: "Stay with us, for it is evening and day is almost finished" (Luke 24:29).
